I'm not sure what my college experience would have looked like without God using Women of Victory in my life, and I am truly blessed to be a part of this ministry.



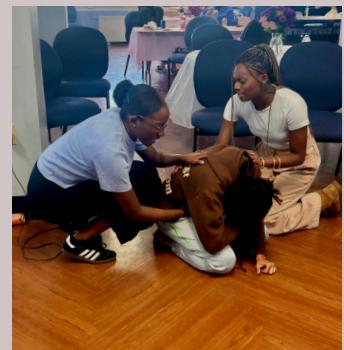
## Our Mission

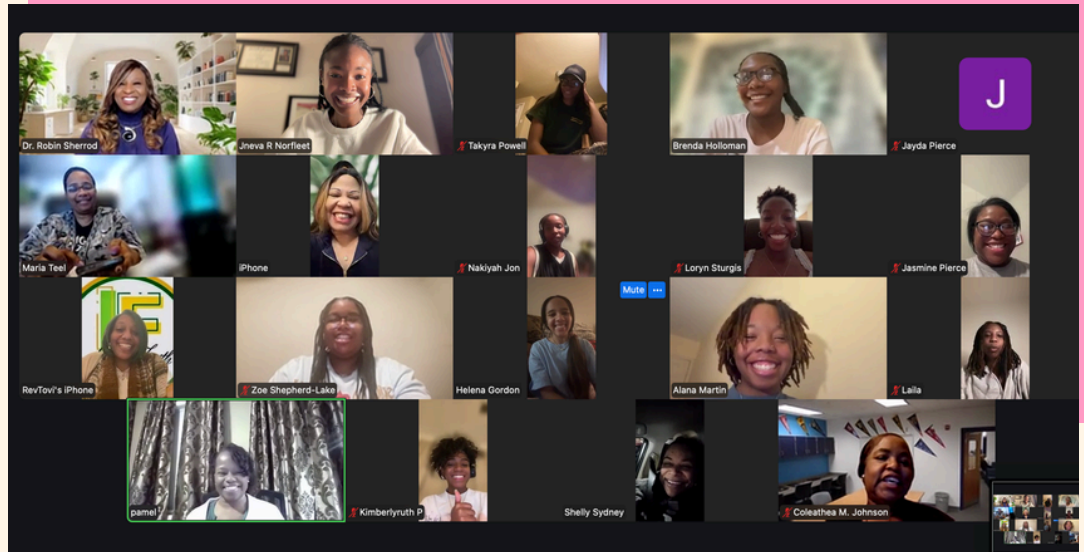
# Women of Victory Mentorship Program

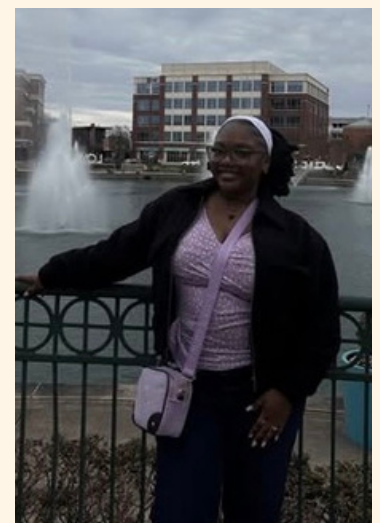
# Women of Victory Internship Program

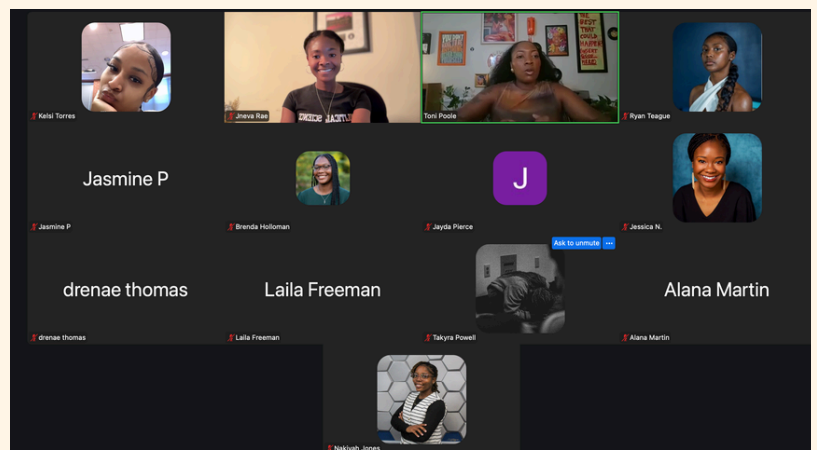
